Updating Stress and Fatigue Analyses to Ensure Code Compliance as Requested by Bulletin 88-11 Item 1.d

In Reference 4, Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) committed to update the stress and fatigue analyses of the pressurizer surge line to ensure code compliance by January 5, 1991. As also noted in Reference 4, OPPD is working to complete the actions requested in Bulletin 88-11 as a member of the Combustion Engineering Owners Group (CEOG).

In Reference 8, the NRC and CEOG established July 31, 1991 as the date for submitting a revised CEN 387-P report (Reference 5) and agreed that site-specific submittals will follow within 90 days of the revision. The revision is necessary to allow the incorporation of results from evaluations currently in progress.

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Therefore, to allow the consideration of any new findings, OPPD will complete the update of the analyses and submit a site-specific response within 90 days of the revision to CEN 387-P.
