Dear Dr. Thompson:

This refers to your summary with Mr. Wilks and Mr. Korolius of my staff at the conclusion of the regulatory review meeting on March 14, 1969. During the meeting, information was discussed on AEC and State licensing, inspection and enforcement procedures, regulations and personnel. Selected State license and inspection files were also reviewed. The meeting was preceded by three days of accompaniments of State inspectors during inspections of Nebraska licensees.

On the basis of this review meeting and our frequent contacts with the radiation control staff, it appears that the licensing and inspection activities pertaining to agreement materials are current and adequate. However, we continue to be concerned, as I have commented following the past two review meetings, regarding the limited number of personnel in the radiation control program and the effect this limitation has on x-ray and radium surveillance and its potential effect on the control of agreement materials. I hope that additional funds and additional staff will become available so that Nebraska can have the balanced and current program that you desire for control over all sources of radiation. In this connection, I am pleased to hear of your favorable report on your budget hearings and hope you realize confirmatory legislative actions.

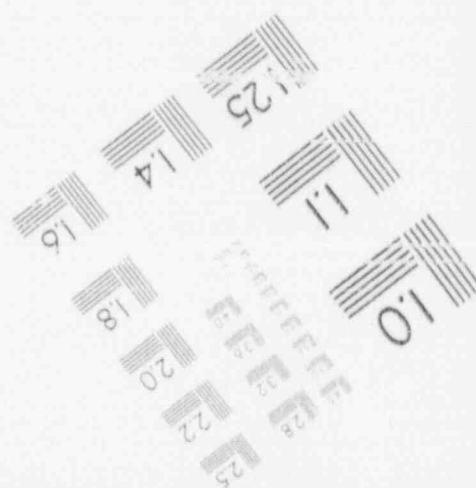
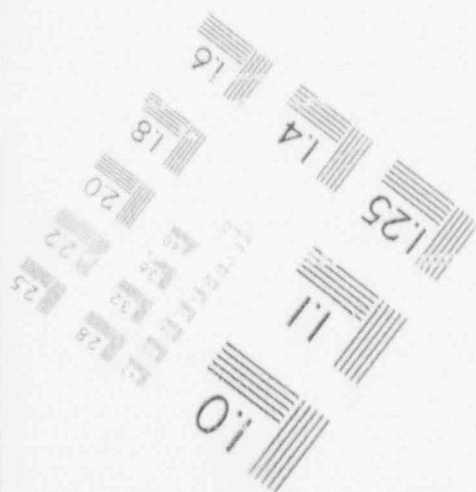
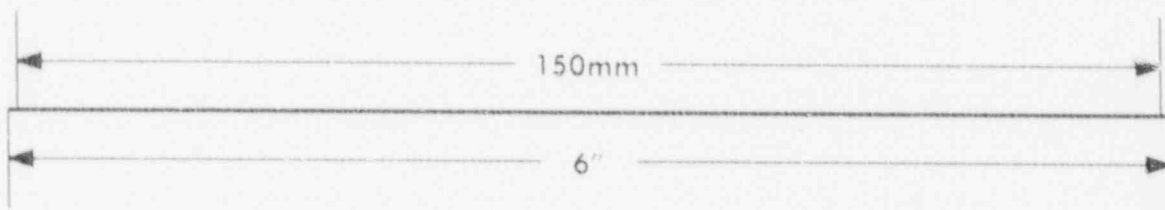
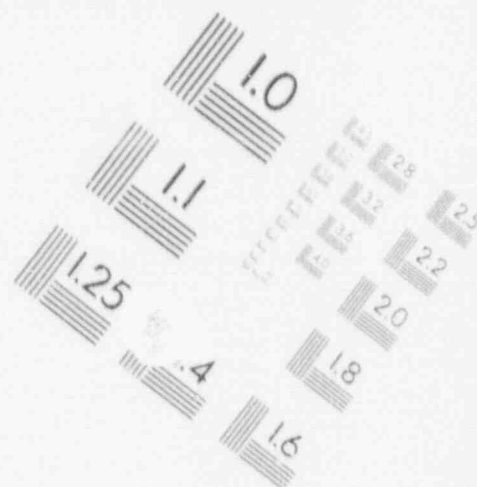
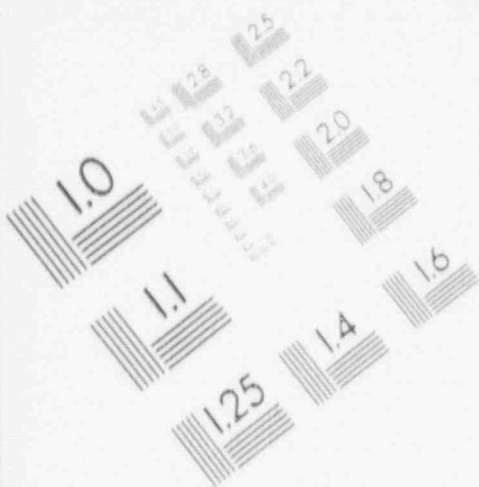
