I am responding to your letter of November 28, 1990, in which you provided the Department of Energy's views on the recent request by the Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) for authorization to ship 137 fuel support castings and 12 peripheral pieces from Shoreham for disposal at the low-level waste repository at Barnwell, South Carolina. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff is continuing to review this request.
