SUBJECT: Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2 Docket Nos. 50-416 and 50-417 License No. NPF-13 File 0260/0840/L-860.0 Confirmation of Lonergan SRV Qualification - SSER 2, Section 3.10(2)b AECM-82/532

The operability testing of the J. E. Lonergan Company safety relief valves (SRVs) for the RHR Heat Exchanger and the fuel oil system has been completed.

The Wyle tests recorded the valve's lift pressure with a seismic equivalent static load applied to the valve's center of gravity. A base line pressure lift was also made before and after each static load test for comparison purposes. All lift pressures were within three percent of each valve's rating, as required by the ASME Code. A leakage check at 90% of the valve's set pressure showed no leakage.

Successful completion of the tests was observed by a representative from Bechtel Power Corporation, and the results were relayed by telephone to the Equipment Qualification Branch on November 4, 1982. Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) provides this information in closure of the issue discussed in SSER 2, Section 3.10(2)(b). When the final test report is received, it will be reviewed in accordance with MP&L's SQRT program procedures. The results of the review will be documented and filed accordingly, available for your onsite review, if necessary.
