SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC GENERIC LETTER 89-13 FOR PEACH BOTTOM ATOMIC POWER STATION, UNITS 2 AND 3 (TAC NOS. 74041 AND 74042)

By letter dated January 29, 1990, Philadelphia Electric Company (PECo) submitted the first of two required responses to NRC Generic Letter (GL) 89-13, titled "Service Water System Problems Affecting Safety-Related Equipment." In its response, PECo provided commitments for each of the five recommended actions of GL 89-13, or to alternative courses of action. We conclude that your response fulfills the first reporting requirement of the generic letter. We understand that you plan to submit a second response in April 1992 to confirm implementation of the recommended actions or their justified alternatives.

As indicated in GL 89-13, nuclear power plant facilities must meet the minimum requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix A, General Design Criteria 44, 45, and 46 and Appendix B, Section XI; and for courses of action different from the recommended actions and schedules provided in the generic letter, the licensee should document and retain in appropriate plant records a justification that the heat removal requirements of the service water system are satisfied by use of the alternative actions and schedules.
