## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Consumers Power Company

Docket No. 50-255

As a result of the inspection conducted on September 20-24, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violations were identified:

 Section 4.11.1 of the Appendix A Technical Specification states in part: "Radiological environmental samples shall be taken according to the following schedule."

This schedule specifies that milk is to be collected monthly when available from four sites.

Contrary to the above from February 1981 until May 1982 milk was collected from only three sites.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement I).

 Section 6.9.3.2 of the Appendix A Technical Specification states in part: "A report shall be submitted in the event that (a) the radiological monitoring programs are not substantially conducted as described in Section 4.11;...reports shall be submitted within 30 days.

Contrary to the above no report was submitted when it became apparent that all the samples specified in Section 4.11.1 of Appendix A Technical Specifications were not being collected.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement I).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
