By Reference (o), USNRC approved the heat transfer correlations in the RELAP5YA program for use in best estimate Loss of Coolant Accident (LOCA) analyses. By Reference (p), Vermont Yankee provided supplementary information pertaining to our RELAPSYA LOCA analysis methodology for the purpose of justifying the use of the program in Evaluation Methodology analyses for Vermont Yankee.
