Subject: NRC Inspection at Washington Nuclear Project No. 3 (WNP-3)

This refers to the routine inspection conducted by Messrs. D. P. Haist and A. J. D'Angelo of this office on August 2-6 and August 30 - September 3, 1982 of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-154, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. Haist with you and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspections.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. Additionally, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with your commitments to the NRC. This item is set forth in the Notice of Deviation, enclosed herewith as Appendix B.

Your response to Appendix A is to be submitted in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201 as stated in Appendix A, Notice of Violation. You are additionally requested to provide a written explanation or statement regarding the item of deviation, describing corrective steps taken, the results achieved (or corrective steps that are planned) and the date when corrective action will be completed.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
