SUBJECT: DEMAND FOR INFORMATION

Enclosed is a Demand for Information relating to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) decommissioning funding requirements set forth in 10 C.F.R. § 30.35. The NRC staff is issuing this Demand for Information because it has not yet received any communication from USR Industries concerning whether USR Industries plans to take any steps toward complying with 10 C.F.R. § 30.35. USR Industries is required to respond to the Demand for Information under oath or affirmation.

For your information, enclosed is Safety Light Corporation's letter to the NRC of July 27, 1990, in which Safety Light (a) stated that 10 C.F.R. § 30.35 required it to provide a certification of financial assurance for \$750,000 or submit a decommissioning funding plan; (b) stated that it had endeavored to obtain a surety bond to provide the \$750,000 financial assurance; (c) stated that it had been unsuccessful in that endeavor; (d) requested the NRC to consider the coverage and claims under several particular insurance policies as satisfying 10 C.F.R. § 30.35; and, in the alternative, (e) requested an exemption from 10 C.F.R. § 30.35. For your further information, also enclosed is the the NRC staff's letter of December 11, 1990, in which the the NRC staff denied Safety Light's request to consider its insurance policies as providing the financial assurance required by § 30.35 and denied Safety Light's request for an exemption from the requirements of § 30.35.

You have already supplied to the NRC some of the information requested in the enclosed Demand for Information, but the NRC requires current information on which to base its decisions. The NRC does not intend to require you to resubmit information you have already provided to the staff. You may incorporate such information into your response to the
