SUBJECT: CLOSEOUT OF NRC BULLETIN 88-10 AND ITS SUPPLEMENT FOR  
MCGUIRE NUCLEAR STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2 (TAC NOS. 71316/71317)

Dear Mr. Tuckman:

On November 22, 1988, the Commission issued NRC Bulletin 88-10, "Non-Conforming Molded-Case Circuit Breakers," requiring licensees to take actions regarding the traceability of molded-case circuit breakers in safety-related applications. The Commission's staff subsequently issued Supplement 1 to Bulletin 88-10 to clarify the provisions of the original bulletin and require licensees to re-examine their previous responses in light of the new guidance.

Duke Power Company (DPC) responded to Bulletin 88-10 and its supplement by letters dated April 3, 1989, April 24, 1989, July 17, 1989, November 9, 1989, and August 13, 1990. Your responses indicate that with the completion of the most recent McGuire Unit 1 refueling outage (completed May 21, 1990), DPC is in full compliance with Bulletin 88-10 and its supplement for the McGuire Nuclear Station. Accordingly, your responses provide a sufficient basis for closure of NRR's review of this matter. Any further NRC action taken will be through the inspection or audit process.
