SUBJECT: UNIMPLEMENTED GENERIC SAFETY ISSUES AT PRAIRIE ISLAND

On April 25, 1990 the staff issued Generic Letter 90-04 which requested information concerning the implementation status of certain generic safety issues (GSIs) at your facility. Based on your response to this Generic Letter, dated June 28, 1990, our own records and discussions with your staff, we have updated our database on GSI implementation status. The results of this effort were presented to the Commission at a meeting on October 25, 1990.

Based on recent discussions with your staff, it is our understanding that implementation of GSI 75 was completed on November 28, 1990 and implementation of GSI 99 was completed in October 1990.

One item is still considered to be incomplete and is listed below together with an assessment of its status.
