This is to confirm and document our understanding regarding the Ludlum subsystem monitor mentioned in our letter of April 8, 1988. This subsystem was originally used in the old fully automatic conveyor system to prevent the inadvertent automatic carrying out of radioactive material to an uncontrolled area.

When the carrier system was changed to a manual system this ludlum monitor was no longer required. Due to a typographical error it was not deleted from the license amendment.

On August 1, 1988, prior to start up, Laurence F. Friedman, Ph.D, C.H.P. of your office conducted a special safety inspection. At that time we discussed with him the Ludlum subsystem monitor and it was agreed that the Ludlum subsystem was not required and we could operate without it. Reference your letter of Sept. 2, 1988 to Tass Varaklis, VP.


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
