
Dear Mr. White:

We have discussed the items proposed in your phone call to Paul O. Shapiro of 6/26/89. Paul O. Shapiro and I discussed this with Mr. John Miller when he returned our call on July 5, 1989. We agreed to the following:

- 1- The soil contamination in the one area outside of our fenced area that is above 15 pCi/gm will be dug up and properly disposed. A plan will be developed and removal is expected to be completed by the end of the year. The two areas inside of our fenced in area will be cordoned off and posted. This should be completed within 6 to 8 weeks of your approval.
- 2- We will prepare a summary of the events relating to the area that was dug up in the northeast fenced in area. Since this was done by person no longer associated with the firm some information may be sketchy and it may take us as much as 8 weeks to complete.
- 3- We will approach NJDEP with a request to obtain their approval to test one of the downstream wells for radiological contamination once a year for two years. A copy of the request will be sent to you.
- 4- A report listing the action required to decommission the site will be prepared and sent to the NRC. This should be completed within 8 weeks of your approval.

Please let us know if you concur.

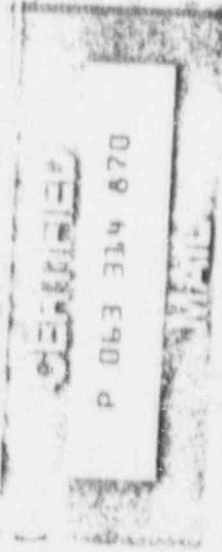

SUMMARY

Mr Varaklis was calling from their N. Carolina facility, informed him that the NRC only recognizes ^{the} RSOs on a license and that this can only be one individual. Asked him why they wished the amendment since one RSO recognized. Told him he could add the information to his back-up material stating that in Mr Russian's absence one of these individuals would be acting, but in order to take over the full responsibility of RSO Schucht - Shapiro would need 3 months of full time hands on experience operating the irradiators.

Mr Varaklis stated that it was his intention to just serve as back-up to Mr Russian but that if the need should arise one of them could assume the position of RSO. Mr Varaklis stated that this would be the case in the near future since Mr Russian has resigned.
