KEccleston The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 86 to Provisional Operating License No. DPR-21 for Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1. This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your application dated October 16, 1980, as supported by information submitted by letters dated December 9, 1981, March 9, 1982, October 15, 1982, and November 2, 1982. Your

The amendment changes the Appendix A Technical Specifications to incorporate revised operating limits associated with the modifications to the Scram Discharge Volume (SDV) for improved hydraulic coupling. These long-term SDV modifications have been undertaken to comply with the design and performance criteria set forth in the staff's December 1, 1980 Generic Safety Evaluation, "BWR Scram Discharge System." The SDV system has been modified during the present refueling outage (Reload 8).

Because better hydraulic coupling has been achieved with the long-term SDV modifications, the approved Technical Specification changes also replace the interim conditions to the license that were imposed by the Commission's Order of October 2, 1980 issued by the Office of Inspection and Enforcement.

During our review of your application we found it necessary to modify your proposal. We have discussed these changes with your representative and have mutually agreed upon them.
