SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 45-25050-01/90-01

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted by Mr. L. Franklin on November 15, 1990, at your facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license with respect to radiation safety and compliance with NRC regulations and the conditions of your license. It included selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and direct observations by the inspectors.

The inspection findings indicate that certain activities appeared to violate NRC requirements. The apparent violation described in the enclosed report is under consideration for escalated enforcement action. Accordingly, no Notice of Violation is being issued at this time. However, please be advised that the character of the apparent violation described in the enclosed inspection report may change as the result of further NRC review. You will be advised by separate correspondence or the results of our deliberations on this matter.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
