At an April 11, 1980 meeting GPU told NRC that duplicate samples of solidification test specimens would be provided to Brookhaven for leaching testing to cha acterize them. We will only provide samples that we consider "successful." NRC requests two of each sample we provide. To avoid excessive casting, the following action is recommended:

1) When resins are mixed and depleted, keep sufficient amounts of each batch to reply, cate successful samples
2) After we have sauced the bonds of acceptability, cast a sufficient number of samples to cover the range of mixes and dep'etions we successfully test
