SUBJECT: EXEMPTION UNDER NRC BULLETIN 4136-44

Your memo of November 4, 1979, to all Office Directors reinstated the requirements in NRC Appendix 4136, Part III, B and D to grant compensatory time in lieu of approved irregular or occasional overtime pay for FLSA-exempt employees whose basic rate of pay exceeds GG 10/10.

This constitutes a request for exception under Bulletin 4136-44. Due to the nature of the on-site activities at TMI, it is necessary for the temporary on-site staff to work irregular and overtime hours. In view of the limited number of personnel temporarily assigned to the TMI Support Staff, we are not in a position to grant compensatory time in lieu of payment and still perform our assigned functions. I am, therefore, requesting that the individuals noted below be given an exemption to permit payment instead of time off for irregular or overtime hours for a period of six months (May 4, 1980) beginning with November 4, 1979, the effective date of your memo. I estimate the overtime hours will amount to approximately 16 hours per week per man for the foreseeable future or at the least until such time that we have staffed the TMI Site Organization with permanent positions.
