The "TMI Radwaste Shipment Procedures" document prepared in this office on March 20 reflected that some states still had not responded, by correspondence to TMI, to your March 6 letters concerning NRC's halt of notifications of our waste shipments to Hanford.

On the basis of telephone conversations with appropriate personnel in the states concerned, here is an update:

Indiana -- No direct contact has been made with Hal Stocks, Chief, Radiological Health Section, in our telephone notifications of shipments on March 14 and April 2. The matter of notification will be followed up when and if we reach him at the time of a future shipment.

Illinois -- As you know, William O'Connor, Counsel to the Governor, has named himself as replacement to the NRC's former TMI shipment contact, Gary Wright.

Wisconsin -- Lawrence J. McDonnell has affirmed verbally that he wishes for us to keep calling him.

North Dakota -- Ronald Affeldt, Director, North Dakota Disaster Emergency Services, has decided he wants only a bare-bones mailgram citing approximate ETA-North Dakota, along with haul vehicle ID numbers. (Travel time, TMI to North Dakota, is nearly two full days.)

Idaho -- Robert Funderburg, Radiation Control Section, has elected to receive no calls, so long as TMI's 24-hour number is in his emergency response file.
