My memo of 14 May, same subject, prescribed certain restrictions regarding the removal of material from within the protected area. This memo cancels and supercedes that guidance.

A large trash container has been located immediately south of the south parking lot. All trash will be deposited in this container. No further trash may be dumped in the old landfill area.

Prior to any trash being removed from the protected area, Health Physics is to be notified in order that it may be surveyed to ensure that no radioactive material is present. (Survey is to be done with an E-520 or RM-14 or equivalent with a fisher probe. Maximum contact reading not to exceed 100 cpm for release criteria.)

Radioactive waste may be removed from within the protected area only under the escort of Health Physics personnel. Waste may not be stored outside the protected area except in sealed drums or sealed LSA boxes. Any such material will be stored only in designated stowage areas.

The contents of all trucks will be surveyed prior to being released from the protected area. A Health Physics technician is on call in the process center for this purpose.

Radioactive samples being transferred to counting labs on the Island are exempt from this memorandum.

Prior to pick up of trash from the dumpsters, in the south landfill area, the dumpster will be surveyed. Arrangement for such survey should be scheduled through the Met-Ed HP foremen with as much notice as possible.

This memorandum does not apply to any trash collected outside the protected area.
