Inspection Summary

Inspection on December 10-24, 1990 (Report Nos. 50-254/90023(DRSS); No. 50-265/90022(DRSS))

Areas Inspected: Routine, unannounced physical security inspection involving: Management Support; Protected and Vital Area Physical Barriers, Detection and Assessment Aids; Protected and Vital Area Access Control of Personnel, Packages and Vehicles; Alarm Stations and Communications; Power Supply; Testing and Maintenance and Compensatory Measures; and Security Personnel Training and Qualifications.

Results: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements in the areas inspected. An unresolved item was identified pertaining to containment access controls during outages when the reactor cavity is flooded. An open item was identified pertaining to the need to develop detailed procedural guidance when using the Redundant Access Control System (RACS) as part of the security computer system.

The security program was effectively managed and adequate resources were allocated to support the security mission.
