The reference furnished written confirmation of a prompt report involving two instances of failure to provide fire watch coverage. This interim submittal is provided pending the issuance of a complete report on this matter. Licensee Event Report (LER) 82-025 is attached.

On October 20, 1982, a lapse of fire watch coverage took place similar to the incidents reported in the reference. Consequently, SCE finds it necessary to review the corrective action implemented as a result of the previous occurrences to determine whether or not additional corrective measures are required.
