

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Unisys Corporation
St. Paul, Minnesota

General License (10 CFR 31.5)

As a result of the inspection conducted on December 11, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1990) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 31.5(c)(8) requires that any person who acquires, receives, possesses, uses, or transfers byproduct material in a device pursuant to the general license in paragraph (a) of this section, transfer or dispose of the device only by transfer to a person holding a specific license to receive the device.


Contrary to the above, during the period of approximately April 1989 to April 1990, two NRD static eliminators, each containing a nominal 10 millicuries of polonium-210 were transferred or disposed of in an unauthorized manner.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

The inspection showed that steps have been taken to correct the identified violation and to prevent recurrence. Consequently, no reply to the violation is required and we have no further questions regarding this matter.
