ORDER

November 17, 1982

We have before us two motions for extensions of time. Joint intervenors seek an extension of time until November 29 in which to file exceptions to the Licensing Board's November 3, 1982 partial initial decision (LBP-82-100, 16 NRC __). ^{1/} Applicant has already filed exceptions but moves for leave to withdraw or amend its exceptions, or alternatively to defer briefing, until the Licensing Board rules on applicant's concurrently filed motion for reconsideration.

Upon consideration of both pleadings, we have decided to fix a common filing date for those parties' final exceptions and supporting briefs. Exceptions (or amendments to already filed exceptions) are to be filed either by November 29, 1982, or within five days after service of the Licensing Board's ruling on the applicant's motion for reconsideration, whichever is later. The 30-day period for filing briefs in support of the exceptions shall begin to run at that time.
