



Consequently, on September 19, 1990, the Acting Director, Division of Accounting and Finance, Office of the Controller, issued an Order to Show Cause ("the Order"), directing the licensee to show cause why the license should not be revoked permanently. As an alternative to filing an answer, the Order provided that, if payment of the fee was made within 20 days of the date of receipt of the Order, the Commission would issue a subsequent Order terminating the revocation proceeding. In response to the Order, the licensee followed this alternative procedure and paid the inspection fee.

III

Accordingly, in view of the payment of the inspection fee under the terms of the Order, and, pursuant to the Commission's "Rules of Practice" in 10 CFR Part 2, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This proceeding is terminated.
