SUBJECT: COOPER NUCLEAR STATION - WITHDRAWAL OF AN AMENDMENT REQUEST  
(TAC NO. 77751)

By letter dated September 29, 1990, you applied for an amendment to the Cooper Nuclear Station, Operating License No. DPR-46. The proposed change would have modified the facility technical specifications pertaining to the inclusion of 161 kV line from the Omaha Public Power District as an off-site power source available to Cooper to power the auxiliary electrical equipment. Subsequently, by letter dated November 16, 1990, you withdrew the amendment request.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
