## AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) ras granted the request of Nebraska Public Fower District (the ilcensee) to Withdraw its September 28,1990 , application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-46 for the Cooper Nucleir Station, located in Nemaha County, Nebraska.

The proposed amendment would revised the technical specifications pertaining to the incluston of the 161 kV Tine from the Omaha Public Power District as an offesite power source available to power the auxiliary electrical equipment.

The Commission has previously issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amenoment published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on October 31, 1990 (55 FR 45884). However, by letter dated November 16, 1990, the licensee withdrew the proposed change.
