Dear Senator Riegler:

On September 13, 1982 you wrote to the Commission's Office of Congressional Affairs to ask that the Commission provide a thorough and expeditious review of a request made by the Monroe County, Michigan Board of Commissioners to appear before the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board appointed to the Enrico Fermi Atomic Power Plant, Unit 2 proceeding.

By letter of October 4, 1982 I informed you that the County's petition was at that time under consideration by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board and that when the Board issued its decision, I would forward a copy to you.

The Board, on October 29, 1982 issued its decision concerning the issues litigated during the April, 1982 adjudicatory hearing held in Monroe, Michigan as well as its decision concerning Monroe County's request and an additional request.
