1. Have Division of Security make a classification review and distribute the report in accordance with the result of their findings. *memo to DC 10/24/80*
2. Set a firm schedule with Dean Kaul, Science Applications, Inc. (SAI) for the delivery of Volumes II-VI of the final report. You can probably expect that these will be classified C/NSI. It may be possible, based on the results of Division of Security's review of Volume I, to classify these without a detailed security review.
3. Determine the feasibility, in coordination with Jack Cusack, BNL, and Dean Kaul, of publishing an unclassified summary of the project and its results. This may require a minor additional funding.

Please give me a run down on the results of your contacts with Ray Brady and John Cusack.
