We have reviewed your letter dated July 19, 1990 requesting an amendment to NRC License No. SNM-179 and find that we will need additional information as follows:

In order to add William R. Martin, Ph.D., to your license as an authorized user, it will be necessary, for you to submit a description of Dr. Martin's experience with the radioactive materials you are authorized to possess under this license. Your description should include the types and quantities of radioisotopes used, sealed vs. unsealed forms, as well as a brief description of the intended use. In addition, the dates and the location where the experience was obtained should also be included in your response.

We will continue our review of your application upon receipt of this information. Please reply in duplicate, within 30 days, and refer to Control Number 89876.

Upon failure to file a response within the specified time, we will consider that you have abandoned your request and will void this action. This is without prejudice to resubmission of the application.
