Dear Sir:

This letter addresses NRC Information Notice No. 90-38, regarding requirements for processing financial assurance for decommissioning.

Pursuant to 10 CFR, 170.11 and reference to "Standard Format and Content of Financial Assurance Mechanisms Required for Decommissioning Under 10 CFR, Parts 30, 40, 70, and 72", Clinton Memorial Hospital's established licensed material levels appear to be exempt from the decommissioning plan requirements. A discussion with Dr. Bill Adams at the NRC Region III office on July 19, 1990, concurred with the exempt status of Clinton Memorial Hospital.

Based on our discussion with Dr. Adams and a review of our licensed material levels and those levels indicated in the decommissioning manual, exemption from the decommissioning financial assurance requirements appears to address both our Nuclear Medicine Section and our Radiation Therapy section.

I have attached a copy of our License for Radiation Therapy. Item 17 references the decommissioning exemption.

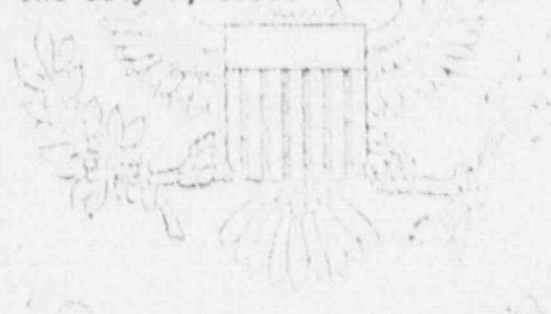

16. The licensee shall establish and implement the written procedures for personnel monitoring as described in Item 10.1.2 of Draft Regulatory Guide FC 414-4 dated December, 1985.
17. The licensee is exempted from decommissioning financial assurance requirements for possession of licensed material in sealed sources in quantities greater than the limits of 10 CFR 30.35(d) for the purpose of source changes only. This exemption is granted for no more than 30 days for any one source change.
18. The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at Clinton Memorial Hospital, 610 West Main Street, Wilmington, Ohio per the provisions of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.
19. This license is based on the licensee's statements and representations listed below:
