Dear Mr. Davis,

Menorah Medical Center has received your letter of November 2 concerning compliance with decommissioning as required by 10 CFR 30.35. Menorah Medical Center did not submit any data concerning this matter because of an April 17, 1990 letter from Loren J. Hueter of the Materials Licensing Section and because of Conditions 15 and 16 of our license. Condition 15 states, in part, "licensee is exempted from decommissioning financial assurance requirements ...". I have enclosed a copy of the letter of Mr. Hueter and a copy of the license showing conditions 15 and 16.

Thus, it is our position that no response was required due to specific conditions on our license. In addition, the source strength limit of 8800 curies is beneath the 10,000 curie limit required by 10 CFR 30. The only time that a greater activity would be present is during source exchange. At that time, two sources would be present in Menorah Medical Center, however they would be in the source transfer cask of the source supplier (i.e. Neutron Products) and not simultaneously in any piece of equipment owned by Menorah. It is not physically possible for Menorah to possess more than one source.

Should this information be insufficient for your request please let us know immediately. Menorah Medical Center would appreciate official notification that the requirements requested in your November 2 letter have been met. Thank you for your time and consideration.

Items 6., 7., and 8. are amended to read:

6. Byproduct, source, and/or special nuclear material	7. Chemical and/or physical form	8. Maximum amount that licensee may possess at any one time under this license
A. Cobalt-60	A. Sealed teletherapy (Neutron Products, Inc. Model NPI-20-6000W or NPTT Series)	A. 6800 curies per source

Conditions 12. and 14. are amended to read:

2. Authorized Users: Arthur Elman, M.D., Bruce Hoskins, M.D. or Robyn M. Hart, M.D.

14. This license is based on the licensee's statements and representations listed below:

A. Letters dated February 25, 1986 (with attached application received February 28, 1986), September 24, 1987 (with attachments), March 5, 1990 and April 4, 1990 (with enclosure).

Conditions 15. and 16. are added:

15. The licensee is exempted from decommissioning financial assurance requirements for possession of licensed material in sealed sources in quantities greater than the limits of 10 CFR 30.35(d) for the purpose of source changes only. This exemption is granted for no more than 30 days for any one source change.

16. The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at the address specified in Condition 10. per the provisions of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.

Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 11 to your NRC License No. 24-01239-02 in accordance with your request.

Please note that we have modified License Item 8.A. and added License Condition 15, which should preclude the need for you to develop and submit a decommissioning funding plan or certification of financial assurance as described in 10 CFR 30.35 (enclosed). However, this does not relieve you of record keeping requirements relative to information which the Commission considers important to decommissioning. Therefore, we have added License Condition 16, requiring that you maintain such records as set forth in Section 30.35(g).

Also, in Condition 14. of your license, please note we have corrected the date of the cover letter from February 26, 1986 to February 25, 1986, to which was attached your application received February 28, 1986.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. You must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:


1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.
2. Possess radioactive material only in the quantity and form indicated in your license.
3. Use radioactive material only for the purpose(s) indicated in your license.
4. Notify NRC in writing of any change in mailing address.

5. Request and obtain appropriate amendment if you plan to change ownership of your organization, change locations of radioactive material, or make any other changes in your facility or program which are contrary to your license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with NRC. Any amendment request should be accompanied by the appropriate fee specified in 10 CFR Part 170
6. Submit a complete renewal application with proper fee or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.
7. Request termination of your license if you plan to permanently discontinue activities involving radioactive material prior to your expiration date.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations in your license application will result in enforcement action against you in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.
