Discussions were held on November 12 & 15, 1982, between Mr. J. D. Richardson, MP&L Manager of Safety and Licensing, and Mr. Floyd Cantrell of your office concerning LER reporting criterion. The following was clarified per the discussion.

1. 14 day and 30 day reports - the reports need to be post marked no later than the 14 day or 30 day requirement vice in the NRC office on the day 14 or day 30.
2. LER reporting guidelines - activities which involve planned or scheduled maintenance work need not be reported per 6.9.1.13.b as long as the time limits specified in the Technical Specifications Action Statements are not exceeded. (i.e., Removal from service of LPCI A and B Loops while in Mode 3 for required system flushing and warmup prior to operation in the Shutdown Cooling Mode in Mode 4).

In the future, MP&L will follow the above guidelines in preparation and reporting of LERS.
