Dear Mr. Dignan:

The NRC Staff reviewed the Licensees' January 28, 1991 submittal of a common reference document (or "Plan Compilation") which the Licensing Board, by Order of January 28, 1991, directed the Licenses to prepare from various versions of the NHRERP and associated documents showing protective actions to be taken in ERPA A.

The Licensees' "Plan Compilation" appears to contain all information regarding the protective actions to be taken in ERPA A (two-mile radius of Seabrook Station) in the event of a General Emergency at the Seabrook Station, including October 1988 amendments to Rav. 2 and February 1990, Rev. 3 of the NHRERP. In addition, October 1988 changes to the August 1986 version of Rev. 2. and subsequent relevant changes are clearly marked for comparative purposes. However, the Staff suggests that it be made clear, in a footnote or an accompanying letter, that the references to Attachments A and C in the October 1988 Rev. 2 version (at global page 64) are to Attachments A and C to the February 1988 Rev. 2 version (at global pages 55-59, 61-62), as no changes were made to these attachments in October 1988 revision.

In addition to Licensees' Plan Compilation, the NRC Staff reviewed the NHRERP itself, in particular § 2.6, and determined that no additional pages need to be added to complete the document. Based on its review of the "Plan Compilation" with the addition of the footnote indicated, the NRC Staff finds the document

sufficiently complete and accurate to be used as a reference document for the resolution of concerns expressed by the Appeal Board in ALAB-937 and the facilitation of the certified question. Memorandum and Order at 1.
