In response to your letter dated December 11, 1990, Reliance Testing Company submits the following:

Violation A. 10 CFR 34.11 (d)(1).

All Radiographers and Assistant Radiographers will be audited quarterly and records of audits will be maintained in the R.S.O. Audit file.

For the fourth quarter 1990, All radiographers and assistant radiographers have been audited.

Date of full compliance: November 29, 1990.

Violation B. License condition 18

Time documentation for assistant radiographers and radiographers shall be maintained in the R.S.O. Personnel files. Date of completion of training shall be recorded on Radiation Safety Program Employee data sheet.

Records of previous training were compiled and recorded. One individual's hours could not be substantiated and his certification as a Radiographer was revoked until further training is accomplished.

Date of Full Compliance: December 28, 1990

Violation C. 10 CFR 34.31 (a)(4) & 10 CFR 34.31 (d)(3)

Personnel Records shall reflect the date of completion of all phases of required training. Tests shall be maintained in the R.S.O. personnel files.

All personnel without records of Field Examinations on file have been Re-examined and records are in the R.S.O. personnel files.


