LPCS Inoperable Due to the Low Pressure Core Spray Jockey Pumps Suction Strainers Requiring Cleaning

Reference: LER 82-094/03 L-0 AECM-82/552

During performance of the LPCS Monthly Functional Test, the suction strainers for the Low Pressure Core Spray Jockey Pumps required cleaning. To clean the strainers, the Jockey Pump and LPCS Pump Breakers were racked out which resulted in LPCS being inoperable per T.S.3.5.1.a.l. Attached is LER 82-094/03 L-0.
