Although I realize that no keply is required, we felt it appropriate to make you aware of our concerns with the wording in the letter. Specifically, "caused significant delay", is of concern to us.

On July 13th, 1990, the late submission of Xenon clearance times and calculations was faxed to Ms. Theresa Hall Darden as set forth in the meeting on July 11th, 1990. Our Radiation Safety Officer was on vacation that week and reviewed everything on Monday, July 16th, 1990, upon her return. We do not feel that this constitutes significant delay in responding to the items that were requested during the routine inspection on July 11th, 1990, and request that this wording be stricken from your letter.
