Be advised that you are authorized to possess unsealed materials in quantities listed in Section 33.100, Schedule A, Column II of 10 CFR Part 33 as well as an unlimited number of sealed sources.

The NRC considers violation of this requirement to be a significant regulatory concern. Therefore, in order for the NRC to determine whether your license should be modified, suspended or revoked, or other enforcement action taken to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements, you are required to respond within 30 days.
