Dear Mr. Davis:

Thank you for your letter of November 2, 1990, in regard to NRC regulations concerning decommissioning plans.

At this time, it is not at all clear whether such action will actually be required from us.

Also, for unknown reasons, we don't seem ever to have been notified, even though you state that as of July 27, 1990, we were "required to comply". On the other hand, it is quite possible that your agency actually sent such a request to us, but I have no record to indicate that we received it. I might mention that one or more of your departments still send material to 5757 Mariemont Avenue, where we left five years ago, despite repeated reminders to please make note of the change of address.

In any event, we are certainly happy to comply, and to undertake whatever needs to be done, within our capabilities.

Please note that your own records should tell you that essentially all our "licensed" material is in the form of sealed sources.


