Dear Mr. Davis:

We have received your letter of November 2, 1990 stating that we are not in compliance with 10 CFR 30.35. Our license lists:

Hydrogen-3	100 mCi
Carbon-14	5 mCi
Phosphorus-32	10 mCi
Iodine-131	10 mCi
Any material in 31.11 in prepackaged kits	3 mCi of each material in subitem 6.E
Nickel-63 foil sealed source	10 mCi per foil

It was our impression that these amounts were below the amounts requiring action under 10 CFR 30.35. Please notify us if we are mistaken. If necessary, we can probably amend our license to bring it below the requirements of 30.35. We have only one Ni-63 source and use very limited amounts of the prepackaged kits.
