He believes that a preliminary plan containing 14 15 sufficient information to provide the Commission with 16 the necessary assurance that adequate funding for safe decommissioning will be provided on a timely basis 17 18 must be submitted prior to the issuance of a POL. 19 The additional concurring views of Commissioner Curtiss and the dissenting views of 20 21 Chairman Carr are attached to the order. 22 Would you please affirm your votes. 23 CHAIRMAN CARR: Aye. 24 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye. 25 COMMISSIONER CURTISS: Aye.
