The purpose of this modification is to require the contractor to present a specialized Regulatory Process Course. The contract is modified as follows:

1. In accordance with verbal authorization given on Jan 3, 1991, the contractor will present a Regulatory Process Course January 7-8, 1991. Performance of this course will be in accordance with Section C.1.3.H of the contract and the attached Statement of Work.
 2. The amount obligated in Blk. 14, of SF-26 is changed from \$78,000.00 to \$83,953.00.
 3. The contract ceiling amount is increased from \$108,959.14 by \$5,953.00 to \$114,912.14.
- All other terms and conditions of the contract remain unchanged.

STATEMENT OF WORK

The Regulatory Group, Inc.

Contract PER-88-365

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the proposed work is to obtain contractor assistance in providing a specialized Regulatory Process Course for the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel.

BACKGROUND:

In early December 1990, the Office of Personnel received a request for a special presentation of the Regulatory Process Course from the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel (ASLBP). The ASLBP requested this special course in order to quickly inform newly appointed Administrative and Administrative Law Judges of the NRC licensing process. The Judges attending this course will be required to participate in various licensing hearings including discussions related to standardization and plant extension.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED AND EXPECTED RESULTS:

The contractor, in accordance with Section C.1.2.h. of PER-88-365, will be required to provide a specialized course for the ASLBP in order to consider the diversity in backgrounds of the participants, and the need to quickly inform them of the NRC licensing process. The majority of the audience attending this course will be Judges, both Administrative Law Judges and Administrative Judges for the NRC. Approximately 9 individuals will be newly appointed, and will have relatively little knowledge of the NRC regulatory process. The contractor will be required to give particular attention to the history and the involvement of the Licensing and Appeal Boards at the NRC.

DELIVERABLE:

The contractor shall present the Regulatory Process Course to the ASLBP on January 7-8, 1991. Approximately 27 individuals will participate in this special presentation.
