Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation hereby transmits an application for amendment to Nine Mile Point Unit 2 Operating License NPF-69. Also enclosed in Attachment A of this application are the proposed changes to the Technical Specifications, which are part of Appendix A of the above identified license. Supporting information and analyses which demonstrate that the proposed changes involve no significant hazards consideration pursuant to 10CFR50.92 are included in Attachment B.

The changes proposed in this amendment facilitate pre-implementation testing of a Hydrogen Water Chemistry System to inhibit Intergranular Stress Corrosion Cracking (IGSCC) at Nine Mile Point Unit 2. The proposed Technical Specification changes contained herein are revisions to Section 2.2 (Limiting Safety System Settings) Table 2.2.1-1, Section 3/4.3.2 (Isolation Actuation Instrumentation) Table 3.3.2-2, and the notes to these tables.

In order to support the schedule for conducting the pre-implementation testing, Niagara Mohawk requests approval of this amendment by May 1991.

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
