SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT OF CATAWBA DRAFT  
SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT (SER)

Attached is a draft of Catawba's SER for your review and comment. We are requesting comments be received by the project manager, K. Jabbour, by COB Friday, December 10, 1982. Because of the status of this application, this short turnaround is requested to enable DL to stay within the Revill schedule. DL has been receiving draft SERs from technical review branches over the last ten months. During this period, the applicant has responded to almost all the staff questions. However, the draft SERs have not been updated to reflect this new information. Thus, DL is encouraging early update and finalization of the SERs so that an accurate assessment of the status of open items may soon be reached.

- It is recommended that appropriate pages or sections of this draft SER be marked-up rather than retyped to expedite processing of the final SER. The marked-up sections or pages should be returned to the project manager by COB December 10, 1982. A determination may be made, at this time, if a technical review branch would consider the marked-up input to DL as the final SER. If a technical branch plans substantial changes between the draft and final SERs, please let the project manager be aware of this decision as early as possible.

DL is encouraging early finalization of the SER because the final SER technical input to DL is due on January 9, 1983. The period between December 10, 1982 and January 9, 1983, has several days of official holidays, and normally many NRR personnel take some leave during this period.
