SUBJECT: EXEMPTION TO 10 CFR 0.735-21

You have reported that, as a former employee of Stone and Webster, you have a vested interest in its pension plan. In order to allow you to work on matters involving Stone and Webster, an exemption from the provisions of 10 CFR 0.735-21 must be granted.

A review of the terms of the Stone and Webster pension plan by the Office of the General Counsel (OGC) has revealed that, as an NRC employee, you cannot influence the amount you receive as a pension from Stone and Webster. Based on this finding, I have determined that your interest in the Stone and Webster pension plan is not so substantial as to be deemed likely to affect the integrity of your services to the NRC and that no provision of law and no NRC regulation would appear to be violated by your participation in matters affecting Stone and Webster.

Therefore, after coordination with OGC, you are hereby granted an exemption of the requirements of 10 CFR 0.735-21 and you may participate in matters before the NRC affecting Stone and Webster.
