CHANGES TO THE RANCHO SECO ORGANIZATION

As discussed in meetings with the NRC in 1990, the District has now consolidated the nuclear organization. See the attached functional organization chart showing the current organization. The changes of most significance are:

- Licensed Operator Training and Security are a responsibility of Nuclear Operations.
- General Employee Training and Fire Brigade Training are the responsibility of the Manager, Radiation Protection/Emergency Preparedness, Environmental Monitoring and Chemistry.

The District has determined the changes are consistent with the current Rancho Seco Technical Specifications.
