Subject: Response to Programmatic Concern  
with Examination Security

Detroit Edison has reviewed the NRC Examination Report provided by Reference 2, which was received on January 25, 1991. The examination report discusses a concern in the area of examination security which was identified prior to the examination administration and requests a response within 30 days of the date of the NRC letter (Reference 2). This letter provides the requested response.

Detroit Edison has evaluated the concern and taken corrective actions to prevent recurrence, as given below:

- o A Human Performance Evaluation System (HPES) (Report No. 90-017) was performed to identify the causal factors contributing to the event and the corrective action required.
- o The Operations Training Work Leader was counseled on methods of effective communications and work direction.
- o An Operations Training Programs Guideline (OTG-15), "Security Agreement Clarification" was issued to assure that the security agreement is thoroughly understood when signed.
- o Operations Training personnel have read HPES Report 90-017 and OTG-15.


