Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Peggy R. Rescheske of this office on August 24, 1990, through January 30, 1991, of activities at the Clinton Power Station, authorized by NRC Operating License No. NPF-62, and to the discussion of our findings with you and other members of your staff during the onsite exit meeting held on January 10, 1991. Further discussions were held subsequent to the onsite portion of the inspection with Mr. J. Sipek of your staff.

The inspection focused on your activities related to reactor disassembly and fuel movement, including preparations for the second refuel outage at the Clinton Power Station.
