SUMMARY

SCHLECT CALLED TO INFORM ME OF THE RESULTS OF A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND BLOOD TESTS OF THE INDIVIDUAL. THE PHYSICIAN AT ST BARNABAS HOSPITAL REPORTED THAT THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE OF RADIATION EXPOSURE TO THE INDIVIDUAL. THE EXAM AND INCIDENT EVALUATION WAS OCCASIONED BY A FILM BADGE READING GREATER THAN 500 REM TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS TERMINATED IN FEBRUARY, 1990. SCHLECT PROVIDED A WRITTEN REPORT OF THE EVALUATION OF THE INCIDENT BY PROCESS TECHNOLOGY EARLY NEXT WEEK.
