IN RESPONSE REFFR TO FOIA-90-A-39 (FOIA-90-356)

Dear Ms. Bauman:

This is in response to your letter dated September 25, 1990, in which you appealed my response dated September 7, 1990. In your letter you requested that the NRC make an additional search for records subject to your request on a radioactive leak at the Point Beach nuclear power plant.

In response to your appeal, we requested that appropriate NRC staff conduct an additional search for documents subject to your request. The staff has completed its search and has informed us that no additional documents subject to your request were identified.

As stated in the inspection report regarding this issue, the resident staff provided augmented overview during the event. They reviewed licensee documents pertaining to the repair activities, including a review of the videotape made to observe the repaired area. They concurred with the licensee's repair action and no presentation by the utility was necessary. The documents reviewed by the resident staff are licensee property and are retained by Wisconsin Electric. The Resident Inspectors did not request the licensee to reproduce these documents since this was not necessary to complete their inspection of this issue.

NRC Inspection Reports are routinely made available for public inspection and copying in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) and the Local Public Document Room for each nuclear power plant. For your information, we are providing on the enclosed appendix the PDR Accession number for the complete copy of Inspection Report 50-266/90014(DRP); 50-301/90014(DRP). Only the portions of the report that are subject to your request were identified and provided in our September 7, 1990 letter.

The licensee filed a Licensee Event Report (LER) regarding the leak incident. The report, LER-90-08, which is dated August 20, 1990, is outside the scope of your request since it is dated two weeks after NRC's receipt of your letter. However, for your information we are also providing the PDR Accession number for the LER on the enclosed appendix.

Finally, NRC staff informs us that the actual limit for identified leakage for Point Beach Unit 1 is ten gallons per minute (gpm), rather than 25 gpm as stated in your request.
