SUBJECT: PROPOSED LICENSE TO EXPORT NUCLEAR EQUIPMENT

TO YUGOSLAVIA (XCOM1054)

On October 3, 1990, NRC received a license application from Rosemount, Inc. to export 21 nuclear pressure transmitters to the Nuklearna Hektrarna Krsko for use in the Krsko nuclear power reactor in Yugoslavia.

The applicant has requested expeditious processing of the license request as the equipment is ready for immediate shipment and is urgently needed.

The staff has concluded that the proposed export meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, and would not be inimical to the common defense and security of the United States.

In view of the above considerations, the staff issued the license without the normal 15-day waiting period.
